

# Fun Group Game That Uses Your Sight

**Object of game:**

Draw an object by a description from another. The Artist then guesses what the object is. Guess right and win!

## The describer

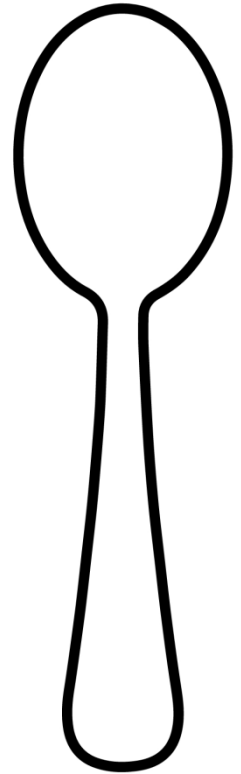
One person has an object or picture of an object. The describer is the only one who can see the object. That person must now describe how to draw the object without saying what it is. The describer is not allowed to look at the drawing(s). The describer should have his/her back to the Artist(s) or be behind furniture. This allows the describer(s) to hold the object without exposing the object to the Artist(s).

## The Artist

The person (or artist) drawing has paper, pencil and eraser. The artist(s) can ask questions, but not name the object until the describer is finished. Again they are not allowed to look at the object.

For Example: what a describer might say to describe a spoon.

1. Draw an oval with the short end facing down.
2. At the bottom of the oval attach a 6 inch long ruler.
3. The width of the ruler is about 1/3 of the width of the oval
4. Now, instead of the ruler being equal across, it narrows to 1/3 of the width of the oval when it nears where it meets the oval.
5. Etc....



## How to divide up the group

Option 1: Have one describer and everyone else listens and draws. In this situation the winner(s) are the ones who successfully name the object. Extra points can be given to the one that's drawings looks the closest to the real object.

Option 2: Pick two people from the group. One person is the describer and one is the artist. You can have the rest of the group watch the "event." Cheer people on! But don't help. You repeat until everyone has been a drawer and a describer. The winners not only guess the object correctly but do it in the shortest amount of time.

Option 2B: For more competition, pair everyone. They can either have the same object or each have a different one. The pairs race to finish the drawing and correctly name the object before the others.

## How to prepare

- Enough objects for people to draw.
- A way to hide the item(s) so others cannot see (use pillow case, bag, box, envelope, and etc.)
- Paper, pencil and eraser- plus a hard surface to draw on. (book, table, or cookie sheet)
- Rewards for winners
